

# How to load your card at a MoneyGram Load Station.

## How?

Locate a MoneyGram Load Station

At the Station, request a Blue MoneyGram Express Payment Form.

Instruct the attendant that this is a "Visa Ready Link" load transaction.

A "receiver" code is required. The attendant should have this code, but if not, for you, this code is 7034.

When asked for your "account number," use your card number (the number that appears on the front of your card). Do not use the account number you would use for direct deposit.

Fill out the full form with accurate information and give to attendant.

Once the transaction is complete the attendant will provide you with a reference number.


Visit the site on the back of your card.

Click the "How to Load" link and then click the "Cash" option.

Click the "Find one now".

Be sure to select "Reload other pre-paid card" as the service.

Type "VISA READYLINK" in the "Biller Name" field.
